

# E) Research Projects







Trabzon University has received significant funding from TÜBİTAK, Erasmus+, and other EU-supported projects, along with internally funded Scientific Research Projects (BAP). Graphical distributions of projects per year indicate:

- BAP projects increased significantly after 2020.
- TÜBİTAK 2209-A undergraduate research projects saw a steady rise.
- EU projects expanded, with collaborations involving multiple countries.











# F) Black Sea Music Archive (KARMA) Project



Established in 2011 under Trabzon University State Conservatory, the **KARMA Project** aims to digitally archive music from the Black Sea region. With support from the **Digital Transformation and Software Office**, it has compiled and digitized thousands of audio recordings from the region.

# **Key Features of KARMA:**

- Stores nearly 30,000 hours of sound recordings.
- Contains printed materials, journals, CDs, books, theses, and articles.
- Engages in partnerships with institutions from Germany, Georgia, the USA, and Austria.
- Develops metadata archiving software to make the collection publicly accessible online.




# **G) Academic Productivity and Recognition**

The university ranked 3rd in Turkey for the highest open-access scientific publication rates in 2021.







Two faculty members from Trabzon University were included in the top 2% of global scientists listed in the Elsevier database for 2023.






# **Council of Higher Education - BIG DATA PROJECT**



Trabzon University was selected as a pilot university for the Higher Education Council's **Big Data Project.** 






