

TRABZON UNIVERSITY





Trabzon, with its 4,000 years of historical heritage, has hostednumerous civilizations and stands as a city where green and blue meet—a center of history, culture, art, tourism, sports, and education.

Trabzon University was established in 2018 in the Akçaabat district of Trabzon. With a deep-rooted and successful academic background, Trabzon University encompasses 11 faculties, 2 institutes, 1 state conservatory, 2 schools, and 7 vocational schools. The academic staff includes 94 professors, 59 associate professors, 195 assistant professors, 149 lecturers, 102 research assistants, and 373 administrative personnel. The university accommodates over 12,000 students enrolled in associate, undergraduate, and postgraduate programs. Additionally, it hosts numerous international students from 32 different countries.

Trabzon University is committed to providing education and training in line with universal values and scientific principles. It aims to produce high-quality outputs and services in fields such as science, culture, sports, and arts through its research and development activities. Additionally, private dormitories and apartment-style housing provided by private organizations ensure that students do not face any accommodation challenges.
